



When a thunderstorm grounds all flights following a huge Muslim convention, four unlikely kids are thrown together at the airport terminal. Feek is stuck babysitting his younger sister, but he'd rather be writing a poem. Hanna is intent on finding a lost cat—and also on avoiding a conversation with her dad about him getting remarrried. Sami is struggling with his anxiety and worried that he'll miss the karate tournament that he's trained so hard for. And Nora has to deal with the pressure of being the daughter of a congresswoman, when all she really wants to do is make fun NokNok videos. These kids don't seem to have much in common—yet. Told from each kid's points of view, Grounded tells the story of one unexpected night that will change them forever.

Four Eyes (Ogle & Valeza) Lexile GN280L

Sixth grade isn't as great as Rex thought it would be. He is the only kid who hasn't had a growth spurt, and the bullies won't let him forget it. His closest friend is unreliable, at best. With so much going on, everything is a blur -- including Rex's vision! So when he discovers that he needs glasses, and his family can only afford the ugliest pair in the store, any hope Rex had of fitting in goes completely out of focus. In this story, Rex has his sights set on surviving sixth grade, but now he's got to find a way to do it with glasses, no friends, and a family that just doesn't get it!


